Grammar Points

A. Pattern #1: Do you... or Don't you.

Sample Question: What food do you like and don't like?

Sample answer: I like French fries. I don't like fruits.

Sample Question: Do you like vegetables?

Sample Answer: Yes, I do. I like vegetables. (or) No, I don't like vegetables.

1. Answer in complete sentences.

B. Pattern #2: How often...?

Sample Question: How often do you eat hamburgers?

Sample Answer: I eat hamburgers two times a week.

C. Pattern #3: Which do you like...?

Sample Question: Which do you like best, dogs or cats?

Sample Answer: I like cats best.

Sample Question: Which does your mom like, coffee, juice, or tea?

Sample Answer: She likes coffee.

1. Answer in complete sentences.

D. Pattern #4: Are there...? (or) Is there...?

Sample Question: Are there trees in your city?

Sample Answer: Yes, there are trees in our city.

Sample Question: Is there a park near your house?

Sample Answer: Yes, there is.

E. Pattern #5: Can you/ your/ he/ she...?

Sample Question: Can you sing?

Sample Answer: Yes, I can sing.



Grammar Points

1. Answer in complete sentences.

E. Pattern #5: Can you/ your/ he/ she...? (Continuation)

Sample Question: Can your friends swim?

Sample Answer: Yes, they can swim.

F. Pattern #6: What makes you...?

Sample Question: What makes you angry?

Sample Answer: Bad people makes me angry.

Sample Question: What makes you happy?

Sample Answer: Playing makes me happy.
